

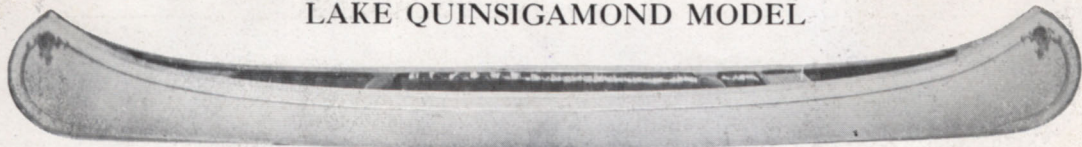

## LAKE QUINSIGAMOND MODEL



After 10 years of careful study of the conditions and needs for a safe, buoyant canoe for use on large lakes, I designed and built this model, which has proved very popular and successful.

It is 17 feet long, 12 inches deep amidships, 35 inches wide, with  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches tumble home on the sides; has a very flat floor and is extra safe and roomy, as well as very graceful.

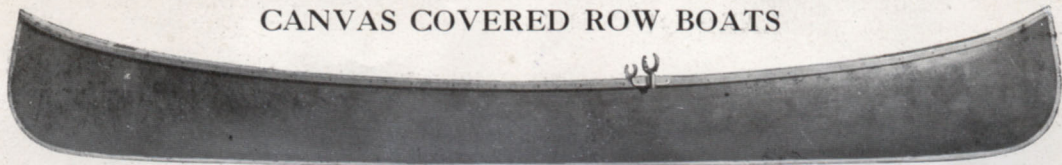

## CANVAS COVERED ROW BOATS



The construction is the same as the canoes except heavier stock is used. The model being designed for great carrying capacity on light draft. This boat will be found very steady and easily handled. Just the kind for ladies' use.

NOTE: The 14 ft. Boat is fitted with three seats, and the 16 ft. with four seats.
