Special construction features in all canvas covered models put these canoes in a class by themselves, features that other canoes do not have and which contribute to their popularity, to their increased carefree use and added durability.

Four practical models are offered, two in the 15 foot class for general use and two in the 16 foot class designed for youth camps, out-tripping, etc.

All are hand-crafted and hand finished and never fail to catch the eye of the ardent outdoorsman.

**Here's why:** **Planking** - of West Coast Cedar in narrow planks with a half-check machined into each edge to form an overlap. Results in a tighter hull and prevents sand etc. from working under the canvas to cause wear.

**Seats** - are rawhide laced and are solidly bolted to inwales.

**Gunwales** - are full length with no splices to economize.

**Keel** - is bolted on, not screw fastened. No working loose to invite leakage.

**Finish** - is in top grade marine varnish and enamels, hand brushed for that added look of quality.

The Deluxe 16 foot model merits special attention particularly from those planning canoe trips when rough going is anticipated and a rugged canoe is required. It incorporates many special features suggested by camp directors and counsellors as being desirable in their canoes to attain maximum service for their investment.

In addition to the special construction features as outlined above for the standard models, the deluxe model offers extra depth for added carrying capacity and extra heavy canvas covering for greater resistance to rough usage. It is also equipped with outside hardwood snouts bent around each end to protect the canoe against head-on collision with docks or shoreline.

Ends on all models are curved up sufficiently to be dry riding but not high to a point where the canoe becomes hard to handle in cross winds.

Centreboard is retractable — when sailing into shallow water, the centreboard is easily pulled up part way or all the way. Board is held in position by a special wood shear pin designed to break if some underwater object is struck. This prevents damage to the boat. Rigging instructions included. Sailing rig comes assembled and packs snugly inside hull.
