It has always been our aim to keep the Kennebec canoes and boats up to the requirements of an ever-widening environment and to be guided by the suggestions of good friends everywhere. You will find in this little book, therefore, canoes and boats that will meet your most exacting needs and that will pay for themselves over and over again in exhilarating sport and good health.

MODELS

The various Kennebec models are the result of years of experience in canoe building and of canoeing in all its phases. Each model represents the fruit of our best judgment of what a canoe should be for a given requirement.

To design a canoe that will meet the requirements of different localities is not an evening's pastime, but requires an intimate knowledge of conditions to be overcome. In order to meet with popular favor, a canoe must be staunch, seaworthy, safe, beautiful in lines and in appearance of finish. It must respond readily to a light touch of the paddle and must be so built that it will give satisfactory service for years.

The extreme care that we take to build to exact measurements insures the production of hundreds of canoes that will not vary a fraction of an inch and is one of the big factors in the wonderful popularity of the KENNEBEC canoes.

MATERIALS

Regardless of price, the materials used in the construction of KENNEBEC canoes are the best that can be obtained. Every rib, every piece of lumber used in these canoes is carefully selected; every piece of canvas minutely inspected; all paints, oils and varnishes thoroughly tested; and every canoe is continually under inspection during construction. There is a final inspection before shipment. EVERY KENNEBEC CANOE IS GUARANTEED TO GIVE SATISFACTION.

COLORS

We carry a line of twelve rich, handsome colors, from which selection can be made; and we will gladly mail card showing these colors on request.

Any special shades desired will be furnished at a small additional expense.

We have at all times for immediate shipment a large stock of canoes in the various models in Type A finish in Auto Red, Medium Green and French Gray. Other types and colors require from five to seven days for completion.

ORDERING In ordering by letter be sure and give the model, length, type and color of canoe. In ordering by telegraph, use the code word opposite each canoe, given in price lists in the catalog. To illustrate, if you wish to telegraph for a 17 ft. KENNEBEC model, type 2A Medium Green canoe, use three words, "Ability Medium Green," and we will know exactly what you want. When possible, give full shipping directions to the station to which you want the canoe delivered.

No charge made for packing canoes in straw and burlap for shipment. If crate is desired, extra charge, \$2 : crating for export, \$4.

DELIVERIES We carry a very large stock of finished canoes in our type A, and can usually make immediate shipment of any of our regular colors. Types 2A, 3A and 4A usually require eight days for finishing. It is well, however, especially during our busiest season in the spring, or if any one of two or three colors would be equally as satisfactory, to name a second choice, and we again urge our customers to send their orders in time to make proper allowance for the length of time it will take a freight or express shipment, as the case may be, to reach them. We guarantee that your orders will be given **PROMPT AND CAREFUL ATTENTION**, but no one can guarantee that transportation companies can deliver shipments perhaps hundreds or even thousands of miles away at a certain date.





PRICES

The prices quoted in our catalogue are strictly net retail prices, F. O. B., Waterville, Maine, and are as low as it is possible for us to make them and guarantee an absolutely first class product, and we will not, under any circumstances, manufacture an inferior craft of any description. We want your business, and to obtain it we give the lowest prices consistent with the production of craft that will merit the unqualified approval of every purchaser.

TERMS

Our terms are net cash with order, F. O. B., Waterville, or we will ship C. O. D., or draft with bill of lading, if 25 per cent of the amount is sent with the order. Any special work ordered should be accompanied by 25 per cent of the approximate cost of the work. For export orders we require cash in full with order.

TYPES—The following is a description of the different types of finish we use on our stock canoes. If careful attention is paid to this, there will be no mistake in ordering exactly the finish wanted.

TYPE A—Maple 15-inch decks, spruce wales, maple seats and thwarts, birch, maple or oak keel.

TYPE 2A—Mahogany 15-inch decks, spruce wales, mahogany seats and thwarts, birch, maple or oak keel.

TYPE 3A—Mahogany 15-inch decks, finish wales, seats and thwarts, birch, maple or oak keel.

TYPE 4A—Mahogany 24-inch decks, finish wales, seats and thwarts, birch, maple or oak keel.

This canoe with the bottom only slightly rounded, sits lightly on the water, yet with any load, from the lightest to the heaviest, is very firm and staunch, and more seaworthy than many canoes of much greater weight and beam. This canoe even though light and buoyant, is equally adapted for use on lakes because of its strength and seaworthiness, and in making long trips where many varying conditions are encountered and long carries sometimes necessary.

The location of the bilge in our KENNEBEC model not only adds to the stability of the canoe, but decreases the draught and also gives it a very graceful appearance. We believe there is no canoe on the market to-day that combines so many excellent qualities in one craft as our KENNEBEC model.

For use in lake waters where breadth of beam and depth of the craft are important factors to be considered, we designed our Kineo model, which combines to a remarkable degree the essential features of seaworthiness and easy action, together with graceful lines that are pleasing to the eye. **This is one of the strongest canoes we make, and is capable of carrying a great deal of weight, and in the hands of experienced canoeists, trips can be taken through very rough water with perfect safety.** This canoe is also well adapted to use on small streams and rivers where it is desirable to use a

canoe of greater breadth of beam than our Kennebec model. For use of cottagers and campers on the shores of lakes who desire an easy paddling canoe, and one that gives the greatest possible safety, we know of no canoe that can possibly give better satisfaction than our Kineo model. Careful attention to the selection of materials used in its construction gives this canoe the maximum of strength with the minimum of weight.

The KENNEBEC "TORPEDO" MODEL is a particular favorite on the Charles River, in the vicinity of Boston, Mass., where canoeing is undoubtedly more thoroughly enjoyed by thousands than on any other body of water, and where greater discrimination is shown in the selection of their canoes than in any other section of the country.

The KENNEBEC "TORPEDO" Model has beautiful lines and a speedy appearance, as well as several mechanical advantages, due to the increased length of water line, decreased out-of-water length, and relief of bow fullness, which makes it less liable to drift. **These lines give a greater draft and displacement for a given weight, lower the center of gravity and reduce the liability of capsizing to the minimum.**

KENNEBEC "ARISTOCRAT" 17 FEET, TYPE A

Although a new departure in canoe building, the Kennebec "ARISTOCRAT" follows a thoroughly tested method of construction—one that has been used for years in building speed boats. The construction is a three-ply system. There are two layers of cedar planking between which comes a layer of medium-weight canvas, thoroughly waterproofed, the whole being welded together with white lead and copper fastenings. This makes a canoe that is well-nigh indestructible, without increasing the weight over the average for canvas covered canoes of the same length. We build these canoes in four different types and three lengths and equip them with keel and outside stems of oak. The inside and outside are in natural finish with three coats of best quality Spar Varnish, which brings out all the beauty of the grain in the planking.

TORPEDO "ARISTOCRAT" 17 FEET, TYPE A

The Torpedo "ARISTOCRAT" is the same in construction as the Kennebec "ARISTOCRAT," the only difference being in the model.

The TORPEDO model is narrower beam than the average canoe, and for that reason cannot be recommended as particularly safe in the hands of the inexperienced, but the narrow beam will appeal particularly to the experienced canoeist that desires a speedy and easy paddling canoe.

For beauty the Torpedo "ARISTOCRAT" is without a peer in the canoe line, the beautiful grain in the cedar planking, which is brought out in the natural finish, and the graceful lines of this craft makes an outfit that for durability and striking appearance has never been equalled heretofore in canoe construction.

largely by children, or in very rough water, or for fly fishing, they are very desirable.

Equipped with one of our Sailing Outfits a sponson canoe makes a splendid sailing craft for use on salt water or on large lakes where rough water is encountered, or, the installation of either a stationary or detachable motor makes a very desirable power canoe, and the addition of rowlocks and oars makes a speedy and safe rowing canoe.

During the past few seasons there has been a tremendous increase in the demand for Sponson canoes. Our method of constructing sponsons is not to put them on after the canoe is finished but to build them with the canoe so that they are a part of it and thus insure the durability of the sponsons. The design of these sponsons, as will be observed in the illustrations, is such that they do not have the "chopped off" and bungling appearance of most sponsons, but are nicely finished with the canoe so that they present an attractive appearance. KENNEBEC Sponsons are far superior to air tanks in the stems of a canoe, for while the air tanks make a canoe unsinkable, it will tip over as easily with as without them. **With Sponsons a canoe is not only unsinkable, but it will not tip over,** and where a canoe is likely to be used

OUTBOARD MOTOR CANOE (Square Stern)

The demand for a canoe adapted to the use of Outboard motors had assumed such proportions that we were prompted to introduce a canoe that would permit the use of such a motor, yet retain the many desirable features of the canvas covered canoe construction.

These are made in the same manner as our regular canoes, except that heavier ribs, planking and canvas are used, permitting more strenuous service than would be possible with lighter construction.

The stern board, or transom, is double, which permits covering the entire stern with the canvas covering, after which the second stern board is put on, set in lead and securely fastened, making an absolutely water tight craft. The transom is securely braced to the gunwales and keel, making the canoe so rigid that there is no vibration, even with the motor running at full speed. **An ideal outfit for the hunter, fisherman or pleasure seeker, making the out-of-the-way places easily accessible.**

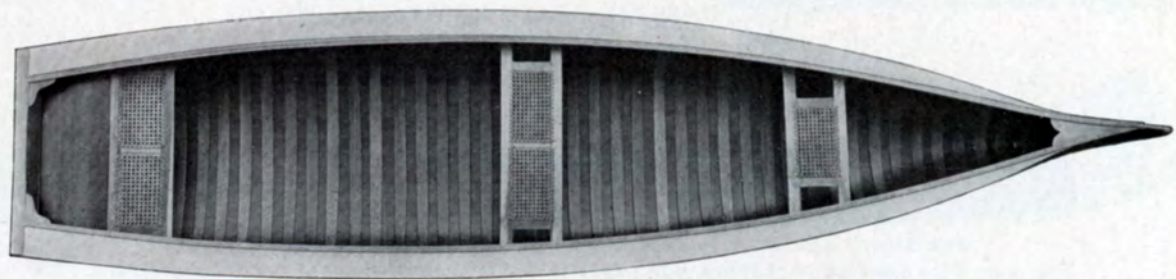

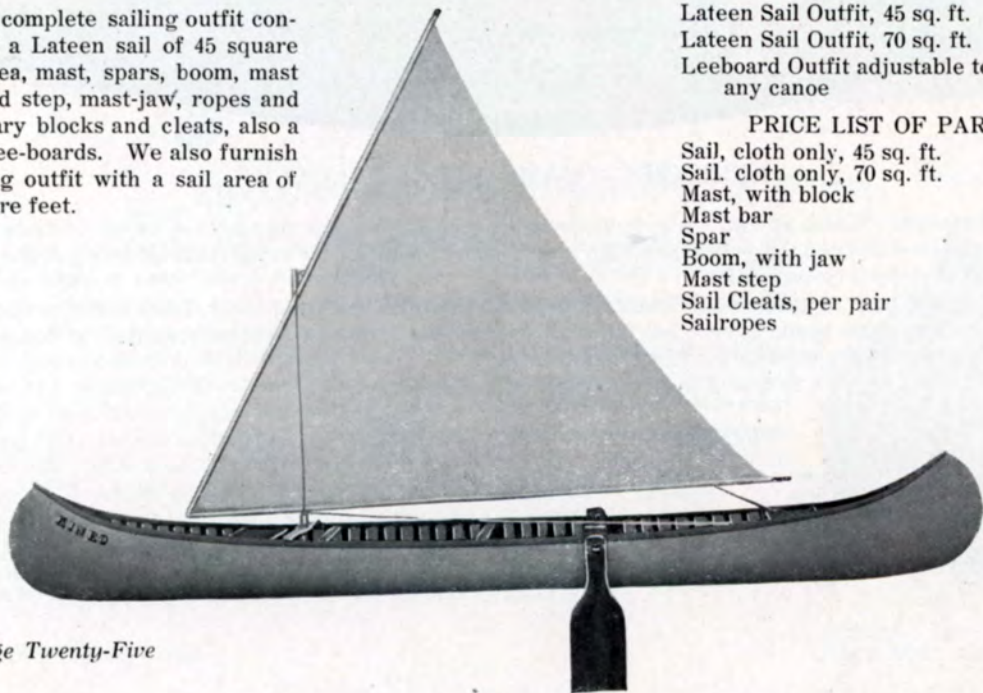
