White's "29" Cruiser



A cruiser designed to carry the large outboard motor. Built with cedar ribs and planking, covered with canvas thoroughly water proofed, this is then planked with 5-16 in. cedar, each plank being laid in white lead, all brass and copper fastened. This method of construction gives all the advantages of a canvas covered together with the durability of a wood boat and reduces the upkeep to the minimum. No matter how long it is kept out of water it will be tight and dry when put overboard. This boat will seat eight people comfortably.

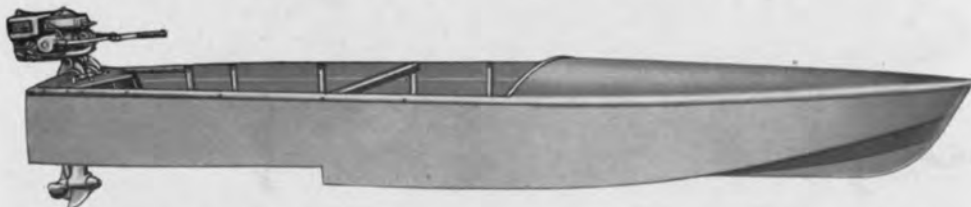

As built by us it has three-eighths inch cedar planking, hardwood frames, keelson, chines and stem, spruce battens and sheer mold. The transom has a rugged hardwood frame well braced to withstand thrust of motor. All copper and brass fastened. Brass bang plate and mooring ring. It has a very light wood deck, canvas covered. . . . It is just the boat you need to lead the race.

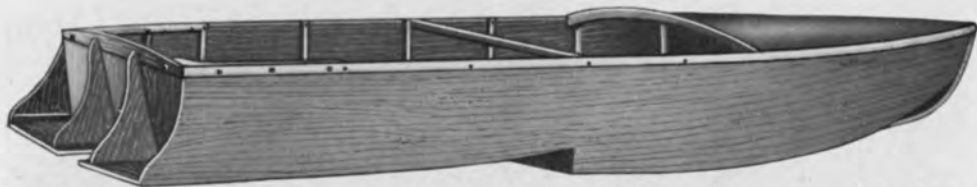

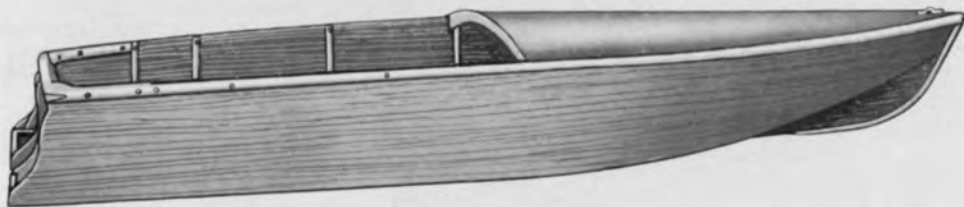

White Dinghy or Yacht Tender

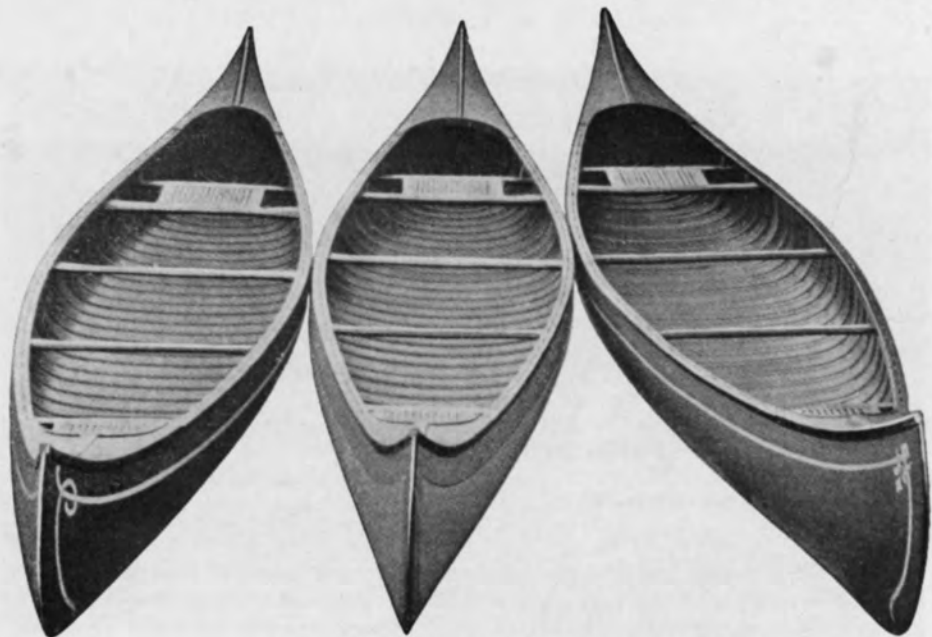

IN response to the growing demand for a light tender of extreme carrying capacity, one that will row easily and tow well, we are building a lot of these, the biggest little boat yet produced. Built entirely of cedar, canvas-covered and copper-fastened, it is a dandy for the purpose. Natural finish inside and painted according to desire without, it combines all the requirements of a yacht tender and is a boat of which any owner may be proud:

There are no seams opening at inconvenient seasons, when you use one of these dinghys. The canvas cover insures its always being water-tight which is not possible in boats of wooden construction. Heavier material is used, otherwise the same method of construction is followed as for our canoes. This boat is fitted with keel, 2 pairs polished brass oarlocks and 3 seats.

White's "A" and "B" Grades—Both Leaders

"A" Grade

This grade provides selected cedar ribs and planking, mahogany gunwales, decks, thwarts and seat frames, white ash stems and brass bang plates. All material of the best grade procurable. In selecting the "A" grade the purchaser assures himself of the best WHITE production in material, workmanship and finish.

"B" Grade

This grade provides for cedar ribs and planking, spruce gunwales, hardwood thwarts and seat frames. No shaky or unsound lumber is used but the ribs and planking are subject to slight discolorations, small knots, etc. For general use where superior finish is not desired they will give as much service as the "A" grade.

The Guides' Special

Is built with low ends. No keel or bow seat unless ordered. Stock color, drab or slate. A canoe built for service—nothing fancy.

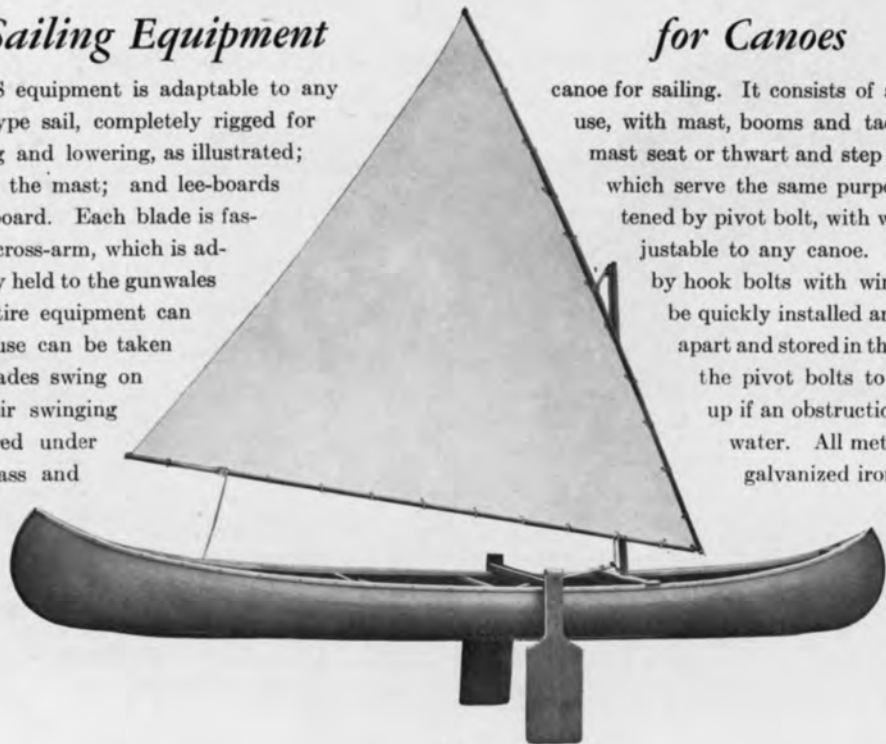

Sailing Equipment

THIS equipment is adaptable to any type sail, completely rigged for hoisting and lowering, as illustrated; porting the mast; and lee-boards centerboard. Each blade is fast to the cross-arm, which is ad-securely held to the gunwales. The entire equipment can not in use can be taken. It consists of a lateen use, with mast, booms and tackle for mast seat or thwart and step for sup-which serve the same purpose as a tened by pivot bolt, with wing nut justable to any canoe. 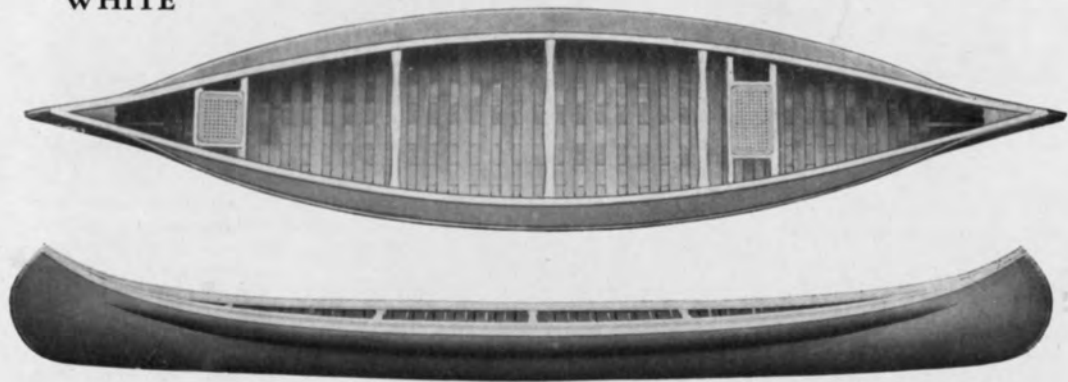
THE famous "WHITE-BUILT" sponson canoes are designed to meet the demand for a canoe that can be used with safety by children, their elders or persons timid of canoes because of inexperience. The sponsons or air chambers run along the rail at the sides of the canoe and provide stability and safety that is impossible in canoes of ordinary construction.

"WHITE-BUILT" sponson canoes cannot be capsized and will not sink. The air chambers insure ample buoyancy under all conditions. These sponsons have a width of from four to six inches at the middle of the canoes and taper gradually toward either end of the craft. They conform so closely to the lines of the canoe that they are not bulky or unsightly and detract not the least from the gracefulness and beauty that characterize the "WHITE-BUILT" craft. The "WHITE-BUILT" sponson canoe imitators have not been able to equal the WHITE product along this line. "WHITE-BUILT" sponson canoes for rowing or paddling are much to be preferred to wooden rowboats, since they are light, graceful, easily managed, speedy, and instantly responsive to oar action.

Each boat is fitted with one pair of brass oarlocks and one pair of plain oars. For oars leathered, coppered and varnished, \$2.00 extra.

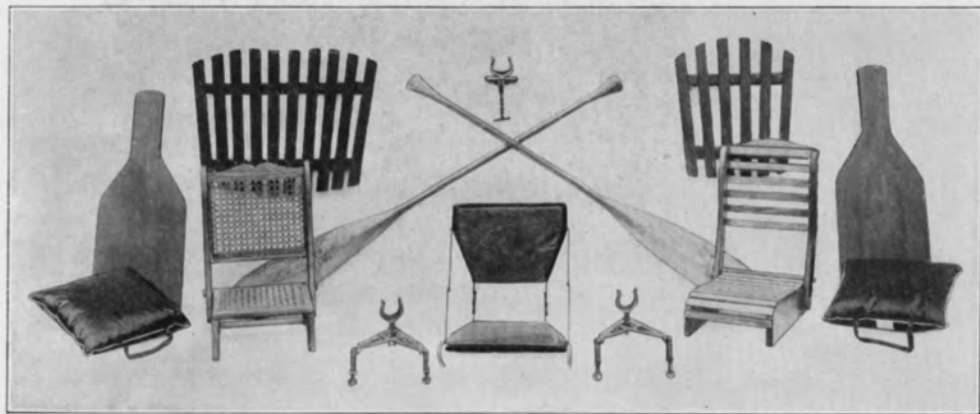

SHIPMENTS AND TERMS
